## SAMPLE ITINERARY

### DAY ONE

<b>Morning</b>	Depart for Dover by executive coach. Option of ferry or tunnel crossing.

<b>Evening</b>	Dinner at a restaurant off the Grand Place. The Grand Place is the hub of Brussels and is beautiful when lit up at night.

<b>Optional</b>	Day excursions - Ghent, Bruges and Strasbourg.
